We hope everyone has had an enjoyable and refreshing break.

As it is January we have made some New Year Resolutions, which will have a positive impact in the classrooms...

As of Monday 16th January:

1. Pencil cases are no longer allowed in school. It has become apparent that these are causing issues around school with a lot of children's property becoming mixed up with school's or with other children's. Pencil cases and contents are frequently getting damaged or lost; many new Christmas presents have already been damaged. School will provide all the stationery they will need.
2. Children in Classes 1 and 2 should only have a book bag and a lunch box (if not having school dinners) each day. Their PE kit should be in a bag that stays in school. If you don't have a book bag they are available from the office or you can collect a large plastic zip up pouch from your class teacher. Due to increasing pupil numbers large school bags, rucksacks etc can no longer be accommodated safely in classrooms.
3. Children in Classes 3, 4 and 5 should only have one small bag of their choice, a lunch box if necessary and their PE kit in a small bag which stays in school. Cloakrooms are becoming overly full, possessions are becoming lost and damaged.

I'd also like to take this opportunity to remind everyone to send children with a warm coat during the winter months. We expect all children to be wearing school uniform with appropriate shoes, not trainers.

Before Christmas, Key Stage 2 pupils were regularly forgetting their musical instruments. Please remind them to bring them in on the correct day.

I apologise if this sounds like a nagging way to start the year but my hope is that if these small issues can be resolved now, we shall all have a happy and nag-free term!


