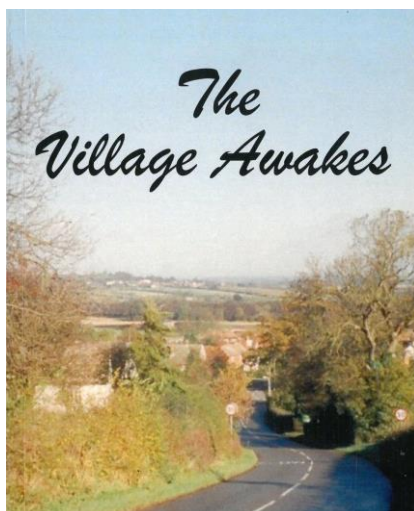
We expect children to attend each session and, for health and safety reasons, if your child is unable to attend you must inform the school.
